Weisiger III, Will Book 1, p. 152, Will of John RUD written January 5, 1753/4, mentions children and grandchildren: daughter Jane and her son Ruscill [Russel]; daughter Anne and her son Thomas; daughter Avis Whitteker; daughter Hanner; son John. Witnesses: Thos. WOMUCK Sr., Francis MOORE, Thos. WOMUCK Jr.

08 Sep 1750. Chesterfield Co., VA, Deeds, 11749-1756, compiled by Benjamin B. Weisiger, III. Bond of John RUDD to Thomas RUDD for 200 pounds 8 Sep 1750. John RUDD agrees not to lay claim to estate of his father John RUDD, dec'd. Witnesses: John FARGUSON, John BAUGH, James (R) RUDD. Book 1, p. 260.

 Amelia Co., Virginia, at a Court Held 12 Aug 1737 The court order entry describes a family of siblings, lately imported into the Virginia Colony, applied for an allowance (of land): "Anne RUSSELL, Hannah RUDD, Elizabeth STOREY, William RUSSELL, and John STORY made oath they had no allowance for persons imported to this Colony." CHILD 1 - Avis Whitteker Rudd

Information about Avis Whitteker (Whitaker, Whittacre, Whittecar) Rudd is not easy to find. The information for her birth, marriage, death, geographic locations, spouse, and children are not well documented or not documented at all on various Internet genealogical websites, so some or most information contained in the family group sheet for her may be wrong. -- Cecilie Gaziano, Minneapolis, MN.

John Cashon in his manuscript, CashonsofChesterfieldCounty.doc, p. 18, supplied to me (CG) on 03 Apr 2009 states: "William [Cashon] was probably born between 1725-1735. There is no record of when he and Avis Whitaker Rudd married. I believe the marriage took place before her father's will was written. John Rudd Jr. names her his daughter Avis Whitaker without surname (he did this with two other married daughters, but he mentioned the daughters' sons in the will, which suggests Avis did not have a male heir yet). By 1761 when [William's mother] Sarah Cashon's will was written William and Avis had four children we can identify through their grandmother's will, three daughters, Mary, Sarah, and Jemima, and one son, David, who was born in 1758. Both William and Avis Whitaker Rudd had inherited fair amounts of property. The 100 acres Avis inherited was situated in Amelia County, Virginia, on the county line with Chesterfield County."

John Cashon's manuscript stated, p. 19: "Avis was still living in 1800 when the census of Iredell County shows a woman over 45 living in the household of David Cashon, and court papers mention a suit including Avis Whitaker Cashon dated April 22, 1805 (John Worsham and Archibald Cashon are also mentioned in these papers." Additional information from his manuscript, p. 20:

1787 Amelia County, Virginia, Personal Property Tax List:

William - one white over 21, 3 slaves over 16, 2 slaves under 16, 3 horses, 8 cattle.

David - one white over 21.

James - one white over 21 and 1 horse.

1788 Amelia County, Virginia, Personal Property Tax List:

William - one white over 16, 3 slaves over 16, 3 horses.

David - one white over 16.

James - one white over 16.

"It appears William moved to the St. Lawrence District of Caswell County, North Carolina (became part of Person County in 1792) after 1788 and died there or in Iredell County, North Carolina, 1795-97." (p. 20).

"The move to Person County, which is located on the Virginia line, indicates William probably grew tobacco for a living and was probably a tenant subsistence farmer, on leased land. There is no record of William Cashon buying or selling land in Chesterfield or Amelia County, Virginia, or in North Carolina in Caswell County 1788-1792, or Person County 1792-1796. However, we know that he did own land, that left to him by his father and the land inherited by Avis Whitaker Rudd Cashon from her father."

He notes that their son David bought 195 acres of land in Chesterfield Co., VA, on 26 Aug 1784 and sold it 21 Dec 1790. He relocated to Cabarrus Co., NC, about 1795, to Iredell Co., NC, about 1796, Burke Co., NC, about 1801, and Montgomery Co., TN, about 1807-1809. Then after 6 years he went to Sumner Co., TN, and in Jan 1825 to Weakley Co., TN, on the north side of the North Fork of Obion River.

CHILD 2 - Anne Rudd

Her father's 1754 will mentions "daughter Anne" and her son Thomas. Her mother's 1771 will gives her husband's name, Ellis Palmer.

CHILD 2 - Anne Rudd (Continued)

She was born not later than c1737 because she was married by 5 Jan 1753/4.

Anne's husband, Ellis Palmer, wrote his will about 1800, which did not mention her, so she may have died before 1800. Mary Gregg, researcher in Texas, estimates that they married about 1753 or earlier. They lived for awhile in Cumberland Co., VA, then moved to Union Co., SC. A deed in Union Co. shows that they sold land to John WHITE on Brown's Creek, 28 Feb 1784, Deed Book A, pp. 60-61. They settled in Edgefield Co., SC, where Ellis died.

CHILD 3 - Jane Rudd

Extensive research on family of Jane Rudd done by Mary Gregg of Austin, Texas.

Jane Rudd's mother's name believed to be RUSSELL, according to Mary Gregg's research in Virginia. Some evidence indicates the siblings of a Russel/Russell family, and wills mention grandchildren with surnames which fit married names of two daughters.

Jane (RUDD) CANNON or KENNON was named in her father's and her mother's wills, so she was alive as late as 1771. She did not release dower when Simcock Cannon sold any of his land.

19 Nov 1778 Prince Edward Co., VA, Deed Book 6, p. 34. Indenture made between Russell Cannon of the Province of South Carolina and ninety six district of the one Part and John Brown, of the province of Virginia & County of Prince Edward of the other part, for £200 current money of Virginia 125 acres in Prince Edward Co., bounded by the lands of John McGeehee, Daniel Frieths/Roths or Falk, and Jacob McGeehee. Wit: William Bibb, Reuben Coleman, Samuel Burton. [May have been part of land inherited from grandfather Rudd; therefore, Jane (Rudd) Cannon, Russell Cannon's mother, may have died before this date..]

CHILD 4 - John Rudd III

Mentioned in his father's will, 1754. Also named in his mother's 1771 will.

He was probably born after 1737 and before 1744 because on 5 May 1758 "John Rudd orphan of John Rudd chose Hannah Rudd as his gdn." He would have had to be over 14 to choose his own guardian, if he was the same person as this John Rudd, according to Mary Gregg's information.

He married Amey unknown, according to Joan Robertson, markjoan@earthlink.net on genforum.genealogy.com/rudd/messages/974.html, 17 Jun 2003; accessed 13 Jan 2008. No documentation. She listed the same children as found on web page below.

According to Carol Rydant, Carol@blueandgrey.net, on her web page at wc.rootsweb.com, last updated 26 Jan 2006; accessed 15 Sep 2008: This John Rudd married Amy Folkes. No documentation. She provided the names of the children.

She said that John (III) died after 3 Apr 1791 in Chesterfield Co., Virginia.

CHILD 5 - Hannah Rudd

Her father's 1754 will names daughter Hanner; her mother's 1771 will names Hannah Cheatham as a daughter.

According to Mary Gregg, The book of abstracts of Chesterfield Co., VA, wills seems to indicate that Hannah married Thomas Cheatham Jr., but "the very well done Cheatham genealogy in THE VIRGINIA GENEALOGIST says (if I understood it correctly) that she married Francis Cheatham." See Chesterfield Co., VA, Order Book #5, p. 15, 6 Jul 1771: Hannah RUDD, Thomas CHEATHAM Jr. and Hannah his wife, and William CASHON and Avis WHITTAKER his wife versus John RUDD, Joseph RUDD, Thomas RUDD, James RUDD, Alexander BROWN, and Daniel BROWN,
