Little has come to light to date regarding the relationship of William Russell to Mary Cannon and William Cannon per the 15 November 1745 record in which William Cannon, an orphan, chose Mary Cannon as his guardian with William Russell acting as security.196 However, as noted above, William Russell appears to have patented land in 1750 that adjoined William Cannon's 1746/7 patent land of 70 acres.
